Sarah Klee Hood Outraises Entire Democratic Primary Field in NY-22

For the 2nd Quarter in a row, Klee Hood dwarfs opponents in fundraising – a key show of strength for the campaign

SYRACUSE, NY – For the second quarter in a row, Sarah Klee Hood’s campaign for Congress in NY-22 raised more than all of her primary opponents, combined. Klee Hood raised \$240,345.26 in Q4 2023, over \$60,000 more than the combined Q4 2023 fundraising hauls of her three primary opponents. Klee Hood’s campaign has been powered by over 14,000 donors, with an average campaign contribution of \$34.

This growing momentum builds on the recent key endorsements for her campaign. Klee Hood’s Congressional campaign has earned the endorsements of over 70 local elected officials, activists, and local Democratic Party members and leaders across the Congressional district, along with IBEW Local 97, Senator Tammy Duckworth, and Congresswoman Chrissy Houlahan.

“Central New Yorkers deserve a voice who really gets it. People like us, a veteran with student loans and parents of young kids, are not typical in the US House of Representatives – which is exactly what we need to change,” said Klee Hood. “I am grateful to all who are supporting our campaign and believe in the perspective a veteran and working mom like me will bring to Washington.”

Klee Hood additionally wrapped the Q4 filing period with more cash on hand than all of her primary opponents combined. She is the only elected candidate running for the NY-22 Congressional seat who has not accepted any corporate PAC contributions in any campaign for public office.
